#### **Seven initiatives:**

- 1) worship revitalization (attendance has not dropped). Reach out in worship to those who are not here.
- 2) Green initiative (solar panels). Begin a capital campaign.
- 3) Staffing changes, team building, 5 new staff.
- 4) Partnership with Good Shepherd Congregation
- 5) Positive changes at Bethel Lutheran Church. This is our biggest church outreach.
- 6) Mission partnerchip: In-Up-Out.
- 7) Stewardship

The economic crisis is really a spiritual crisis.

# Time to focus on the Sabbath (7<sup>th</sup> day):

- a) Rest: step back and re-access.
- b) Study: Bible study groups, prayer, worship
- c) Get out of your comfort zone and do something new, volunteer, sit somewhere else in church.
