Report again focuses on five directions of ministry identified from small groups' discussions last summer

- i –Serve
  - Viewed as important to many members
- Worship
  - Sunday morning worship schedule altered to accommodate Sunday morning Bible study/adult education
- Children & Families
  - Need leadership in this area
  - o Call committee has identified this as an important area for pastoral call
- Engaging Communication
  - o Area to improve upon
  - o Need single source for information dissemination
  - Currently much communication is via one-way information dissemination from Bethel leadership to members
  - Blogs or other social media may facilitate conversation among members
- Relationship Building (Evangelism)
  - o Forming relationships with others first, then bring to Christ
  - o More efforts needed in this area

## **Call Committee Update**

**Call Committee Members** 

- Conducted/participated in many venues to obtain good understanding of Bethel's needs
  - Data used to develop Ministry Site Profile used by synod to match with data from Rostered Leader Profiles
- Excellent candidate found (whom the Call Committee recommended to call), but declined to pursue due to cost of living in Bay Area
  - Used synod guidance found amount not sustainable for renting or home purchase
- Ministry Site Profile delineates five areas of vision desired in a senior pastor
  - Preaching/worship
  - o Administrative skills
  - Evangelism and mission
  - Recruit and equip leaders
  - Strategic mission planning
    - Experience in growing a church
    - Experience in working with church and school
  - These areas were validated with Synod office to ensure the qualities best match with meeting our needs
- Candidates vetted by call committee, then by Synod
  - o Interviews by Skype
  - o In-person meeting
  - o Confidentiality to protect candidates
  - Nothing in Rostered Leader Profile regarding current/past salary

- Call Committee commissioned to call a lead pastor
  - Council continues to review this decision
    - Current plan is to continue with this commission

# **Budget for FY 2015**

**Eric Brown** 

- FY 2014 update
  - Giving stabilized over current year at \$625,000
  - Spending 17% below budget
  - o Giving 6% below budget
  - Church unencumbered assets \$188K
    - Includes net ordinary income surplus of \$82K
- Facility Use income projected to be \$51K
- Budgeted expenses (excluding depreciation) \$751K
  Income (facility use & fee-based events) \$91K
  Net Expenses \$660K
  Projected Giving \$625K
  Net income deficit \$35K
  - o Covered with unencumbered assets
- Long term growth will lead to new income
- Thanks to the congregation for continued financial support
