BENEVOLENCE BUDGET FY 2015

Bethel commits to giving away 7.5% of the offering that our church receives as benevolence to outside ministries and non-profit organizations. On top of these 7.5%, the Bethel community generously contributes to recipients of monthly special designated offerings and provides relief for unforeseen catastrophic needs (especially through Lutheran Disaster Relief). Together, these annual benevolence offerings exceed 10% of our budget.

Bethel's Mission Outreach Committee annually develops a schedule of recipients which reflect areas of ministries that are important to our congregation (hunger, homelessness, poverty, women, children; locally and abroad, especially in Mexico and Tanzania).

Any amounts that are left over after these outside groups are funded is given to the Sierra Pacific Synod in support of regional and churchwide ELCA ministry efforts.

The FY 2015 benevolence budget is based on \$625,000 in projected offerings. Slightly over half of the budgeted benevolence will be given to outside ministries and non-profit organizations, whereas slightly under half will be given in support of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (Sierra Pacific Synod and ELCA churchwide).
