Here are tips for finding a therapist/psychologist/psychiatrist:

- 1) Check your health insurance and see who is in your plan.
- 2) See psychologytoday.com for a listing of possible candidates for you to pursue.
- 3) If you are thinking about employing a psychiatrist (one who prescribes medication) make sure that they also provide regular therapy, so they can monitor how you are handling the medication.
- 4) Love yourself enough to find the right fit. It may take a while.
