Who do you talk to about your faith story? Who do you want to talk to about your faith story? Who are people whose input to

your faith story you've decided not to listen to anymore? Who are people who need to hear your faith story? Like writing - prayer, meditation, and our relationship to God can feel like a solo activity - but in fact, just as the story itself contains many characters, the writing and crafting of the story can be so much richer when we invite more people in.
